

food and drink policy

In general, food and drinks are allowed in my class. This is contingent on it not becoming a distraction in class, and as long as students can handle the responsibility. This policy is subject to change at my discretion, and at any time.



Students are expected to use the restroom on their own time. If needed students may use the restroom during non-instructional time and not within the first or last 15 minutes. Restroom breaks will be limited to 5 minutes.

This is a privilege not law. Discretion will be up to Mr. Young and you must follow all LHS rules while out of the classroom.

Homework and Cheating

Most work will be able to be completed in class if students use their time wisely. The exception to this would be if stated otherwise by Mr. Young and studying.

Cheating is defined as acquiring or presenting someone else's work as your own. Allowing another student to copy your work will also be considered cheating.



Any student involved in cheating (including cell phone use) will receive a zero for that assignment, quiz, or test which can not be replaced, dropped or retaken. In addition, parents and AP's will be notified.

policy for absences & grades

Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly (bell ringers, participation, and quizzes). Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent).

All make-up work will be held by Mr. Young for you to collect. It is your responsibility to ask a classmate or Mr. Young for help on making up any notes and/or to meet with Mr. Young to make up any tests, quizzes or papers.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask Mr. Young for your make-up work before the absence.

This can be done before or after school or via e-mail.

electronic devices

Electronic devices will NOT be allowed in class, unless otherwise instructed by the teacher or with permission.

Electronic devices will be collected everyday at the door before a student is allowed to enter. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Phones will be returned when class work is finished. Any questions or issues do not be afraid to talk to Mr. Young.

Consequences: Refusal and/or lying will lead to an office referral.
